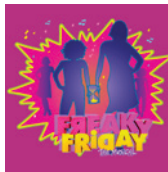
Zooming Fun

Looking Forward to Returning to the Theater

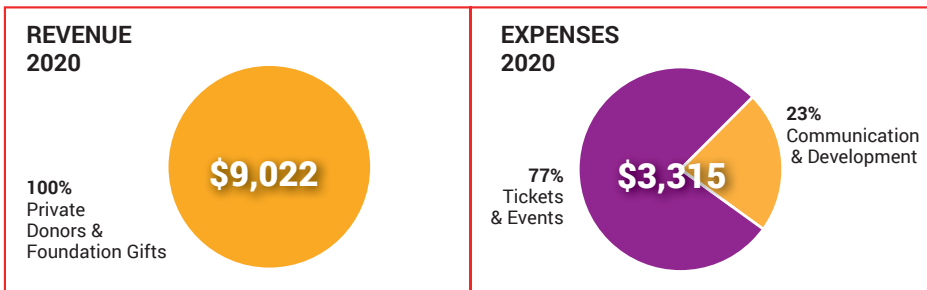
